DPH Palliative Care

Founded in 1992, Dover Park Hospice (DPH) is Singapore's first purpose-built hospice, catering to those nearing their end of life's journey.

Through a transdisciplinary team comprising doctors and nurses, medical social workers, art therapists, music therapists, physiotherapists and occupational therapists, the team jointly assesses, discusses and plans for the care of the patients and support for their caregivers.

Over the years, Dover Park Hospice has served over 22,000 patients and families, providing holistic palliative care in meeting their physiological, emotional, psychosocial and spiritual needs.

As a charity with Institute of Public Character (IPC) status, DPH relies on the generous donations from corporations and individuals to provide holistic palliative care and vital support for patients and their caregivers.

Remembering Mr Saad's Legacy

Mr Saad had always possessed an active imagination since childhood and worked diligently to bring his artistic visions to life. Initially uncertain about the quality of his work, he was heartened when friends and relatives embraced it.



Caregiver Story: Helping Patients to Die with Dignity

"My father has no chance of recovery. He is 86 years old. We don't want him to suffer a life without quality of life and full of pain. More importantly, we want to respect his wishes."

Respecting her father's wishes to pass away at home

Ms Julie Huang's father passed away at the age of 86 years in January 2024, where his wish to die peacefully at home was honoured. Although doctors offered a tracheostomy to aid his breathing, he had made an Advance Care Plan four years earlier, declining invasive treatment. The family respected his wishes and arranged for his discharge the next day.

Seamless medical support provided for a comfortable goodbye

Ms Huang shared that although her father was unconscious before passing, he remained calm and peaceful. She praised the seamless coordination between the hospital's palliative care team and Dover Park Hospice, which helped with medical equipment, medication, and provided spiritual support for the family.

医院及业者临终出院程序划一

一年多来 更多病患回家走完人生路

去年5月推出的临终出院安排标准化程序，包括制定六个步骤的框架，以及注意事项清单，以协调病人从医院转移到住家的交接工作，同时加强医院、关怀护理业者及看护者之间的沟通。

自卫生部与护理中心、以及医院及治疗护理业者合作，就临终出院推出标准化程序后，病患回家度过人生最后几天的案例，有渐增现象。

临终出院（compassionate discharge）是一项让临终病人出院回家的特殊安排。这些病人一般只有少过七天的生命。他们出院后在家接受居家关怀护理直至过世。

这包括制定六个步骤的程序框架，以及注意事项清单。更好地协调治疗病人从医院转移到住家的交接工作，同时加强医院、关怀护理业者及看护者之间的沟通。

尽管如此，根据个别关怀护理业者提供的《联合早报》的数据，临终出院近年有渐增的趋势，而今年以来也较为明显。

HCA关怀护理是本地最大的居家关怀护理业者。前年转介至这家机构的临终出院案例约330起，比2020年的260起增27%。去

年，总案例量略减至310起，但新的案例约九成。比前年的75%增多。新案例指的是不曾接受这个服务。然而，由于不同医院过去对临终出院的做法不同，同一家医院不同部门的做法也未必一致，卫生部之前没有像如今这样持续修订相关案例，也就无法对比过往数据。

HCA关怀护理早前的一项研究显示，不仅一般人对临终出院不了解或有不同理解，就算是医院也有医生不大确定如何判断病人是否适合接受临终出院，或不熟悉相关程序。

至于位于裕廊关怀机构托福园，

其居家护理部门自2023年至2024年，每年处理的临终出院案例介于83起至85起，比前年每年约50起更多。今年首五个月则有44起，意味着全年案例可能进一步增多。

HCA关怀护理是本地最大的居家关怀护理业者。前年转介至这家机构的临终出院案例，占目前总数超过一半。

张保贤也是新加坡关怀理事

会副主席。他指出，冠病疫情期间，医院限制访客人数。不少家属希望把即将离世的老人带回家，是近年临终出院增加的其中一个因素。

HCA关怀护理早前的一项研究显示，不仅一般人对临终出院不了解或有不同理解，就算是医院也有医生不大确定如何判断病人是否适合接受临终出院，或不熟悉相关程序。

因此，临终出院案例增加，意味着标准化程序推出后取得初步成效，医生对这项出院安排更加了解。不过张保贤指出，并非所有临终病人想要在家中过世。

“我们的工作是为病人提供这个选项，聆听病人和家属的需求，完善这项临终关怀的工作。”



业者试行周末及假日也处理临终出院

HCA关怀护理试行新措施，包括在周末和公共假期也能接手处理临终出院案例，让想回家度生命的临终病人，更顺利出院。

HCA医疗总监兼男医生说，临终出院在本地还不够普遍，目前一年可达的最高案例数量，也不得而知。尽管如此，机构仍决定试行一系列措施，包括在周末和公共假期处理案例，希望能帮助更多有需要的病人实现临终出院的心愿。

HCA预计，2024财年的员工总数，会比上个财年增16%，并且希望护士人数据增23%。

此外，HCA在与指定医院合作，就划一临终出院程序，了解医生、关怀护理业者及看护者的体验，探讨如何改进。

托福园服务逐步扩展至全国。托福园居家护理部门与陈笃生医院的关怀护理团队，

24小时热线服务提供引导 家属更安心

宋龙昌生前认为，看医生能免灾。尤其忌讳踏入医院。无奈每年经常进入这个令他不好的地方。他曾告诉家人，要在家过世，而不是在医院。

家人尊重他的意愿，让他在人生最后一个月，接受居家关怀治疗。虽然他过世的三天前，因气喘紧急入院，他最终还是出院，在家人陪伴下咽下最后一口气。

宋龙昌今年6月3日逝世，享年82岁。他与妻子育有三个女儿。

长女宋善美（55岁，客户执行员）说，父亲患有甲状腺疾病多年，去年被诊断患肺癌。由于他年事已高，家人和医生商讨后，决定不采取积极治疗。不料，他几个月后又被诊断患心脏病。

每周两次家访检查，引导家人帮照护伤口。

4月底，医生建议让宋龙昌出院回家。接下来一个月，HCA关怀护理团队与居家护理部门，准备增聘人手。我们按指示拨电通报，随后一名医生也接受临终出院安排。

随着服务区域扩大，托福园居家护理部门也准备增聘人手。目标是最近在2025年。任何时候可服务的病人，从目前的380增至500名。

卫生部早前宣布，计划到2025年底，将居家关怀护理名额增加50%，至3600个；将住院关怀护理服务的床位增加15%，至300个；以及将日间关怀护理服务的名额增加12%，至140个。

医生得知他在接受关怀治疗，不建议他插管，并估计他只剩下约一周的生命。院方自动将他转至陈笃生医院，让宋龙昌最后一次出院。

宋善美说，父亲患帕金森症已有10年，今年1月15日突然出现口水困难，伴有呼吸困难。家人将他送入陈笃生医院，才发现他感染新冠病毒。他随后转入居家传染病中心治疗。

院方进行出院安排，并与托福园居家护理团队协调。黄美玲的父亲顺利抵家后，一小时内逝世。当时，至亲和爱人都在他身边。

黄美玲相信，临终出院的安排是正确的。

“父亲临终前虽不消瘦，但看得出他很平静，没有丝毫挣扎。”

她指出，陈笃生医院关怀护理团队与托福园的协调，可说是无缝衔接，这包括协助他们向供应商租用医疗设备，为他们在注射器填入正确剂量的药物等，并给予她和家人扶持与安慰。
